	there must be a very high 'added value' to the artistic content of the
	finished article in order to justify participation
3	If specifically designed by, but not made by, the exhibitor then there
	must be a significantly high amount of collaboration between designer
	and fabricator in order to justify participation

#### **Criteria Notes:**

We do not allow any bought in products.

If you are requesting application/s for the Taster Stalls then Point 3 is **not** applicable. In order to be considered only Points 1 and/or 2 need to apply.

Priority will always be given to those exhibitors who make their own products as we are committed to ensuring the perpetuation of handmade work.

To maintain the quality of products you may be asked to clarify these criteria.

Our decision with regards to acceptance is final.
